


## Brereton PTA Uniform Shop – We're Going Online!

### Top tips!


We recommend refining your search by 'Category' to display the maximum number of results

There is now the ability to filter on sizes if you are looking for multiple items in a certain size range.

The majority of items are listed as 'Unisex' for inclusivity

**Please note:** We don't have the ability to photograph every item so we try to show the type of item you are purchasing, therefore there may be some slight differences in the actual garment you purchase, however all are checked to make sure you are getting a good quality item.

3. Find the item(s) you want and add to your basket
4. Click on the shopping trolley icon (top right) to checkout
5. Pay with your card. You will then receive a confirmation email with instructions on how to collect your item(s).
