	Rainbow/Gold	Sunshine/Silver	Cloud/Grey	Thundercloud/Black
EYFS	Rainbow – 5 do jos	Sunshine – 1 Do jo	Cloud – minus a Do jo	Thundercloud – miss 5 mins of break
Y1-3	Rainbow – 5 do jos	Sunshine – 1 Do jo	Cloud – minus a Do jo	Thundercloud – miss 10mins of break
Y4-6	Gold – 5 do jos	Green – 1 Do jo	Amber – minus a Do jo, miss 5 mins of break	Red – miss all of break,

- Charts must be easily accessible for teachers to be able to move names.
- Red– aim for KS2 pupils to have time with an adult, doing a job – inclusive rather than excluding. Use the time to reflect on the behaviour and dig into the reasons for it.
- Message home if there has been a physical altercation (ideally in person or phone)
- Behaviour incidents should be recorded on CPOMS. Please alert a member of SLT.

SEND

- Pupils with EHCPs/specific needs to have their own charts. Start in the middle of the circle and move outwards.
- Social stories to be used to teach and reflect on behaviour.
- Individualised rewards to be used (working towards, sticker chart etc) with clear, achievable target.
