Play Area

The route out of lockdown is underway and we are looking forward to a 'normal' summer. In order to get there, we have to continue to make sacrifices for a few more weeks.

One area causing concern for a number of schools is the use of local parks and playgrounds, and this includes our community space opposite the school. We are sure that as the weather improves, many parents will want to make use of this space after school. The current guidance around parks is as follows:

"Under the national lockdown announced on 4 January outdoor public playgrounds can remain open. This is primarily for use by children who do not have access to private outdoor space, like their own garden. Although parents, guardians or carers can take children to a playground for exercise, they must not socialise with other people while there.

Social distancing guidelines should be followed wherever possible. This means a distance of 2 metres between people from different households"

The latest easing allows us to meet with one other outside but social distancing should still be observed. We would urge parents to be cautious. We are keeping children in year group bubbles throughout the school day in order to try and keep our school community as safe as possible. A number of our families have vulnerable members who could become very poorly and we want to do what we can to keep them safe.

We know that play, exercise and socialisation are important to children's development but we ask that parents consider the risk and take steps to keep themselves, their families and our school community as safe as possible. Thank you for your support.

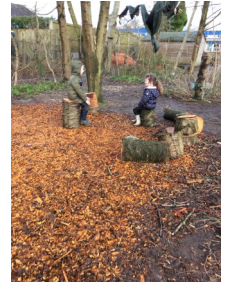


Easter Egg Raffle
