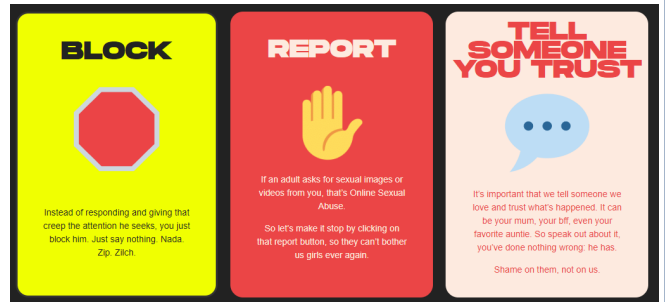

- Test results received within the hour
