You may have noticed a green box outside the entrance to school. Recently we have had a defibrillator fitted. A defibrillator is a device that gives a high energy electric shock to the heart through the chest wall to someone who is in cardiac arrest. This high energy shock is called defibrillation, and it's an essential life saving step in the chain of survival. Our defibrillator has been sited outside so that both school and community can use it, should it be needed.
