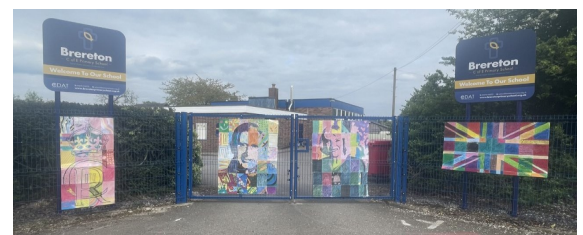


Swimming Achievement
