The photographer will be coming into school on Monday morning to take the children's class photographs. Please ensure your child has their full uniform in school.

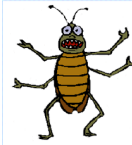
Race for Life

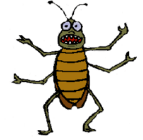
Music Extravaganza
