Minster, the city itself and ice cream (thank you Mrs McLean)! Their knowledge of

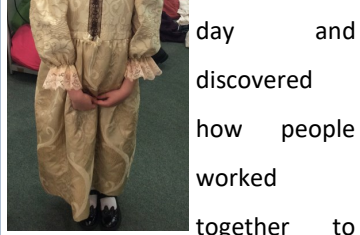
the Vikings has been brought to life and we
