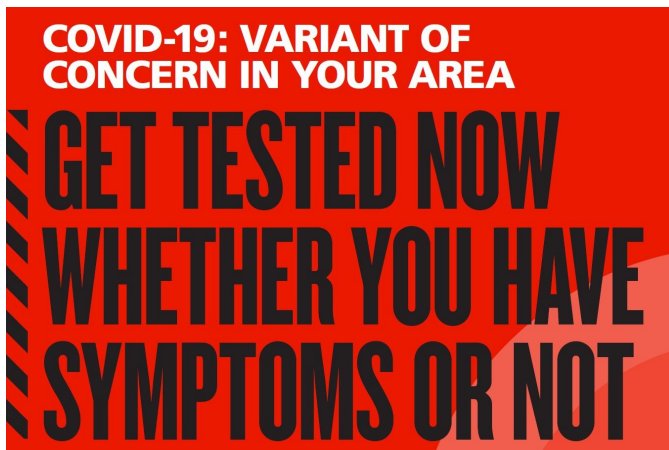

Unfortunately, we have received reports of headlice in school. Please can we ask all parents to check their children's hair over the weekend.

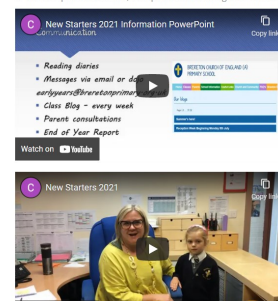
New Starters' Meeting

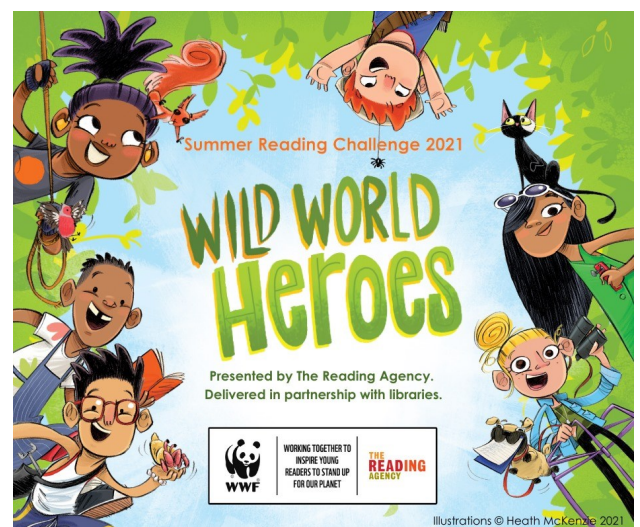
Reception 2021/22

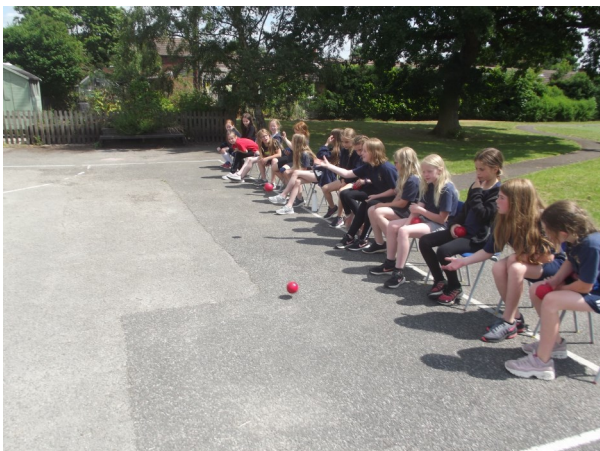
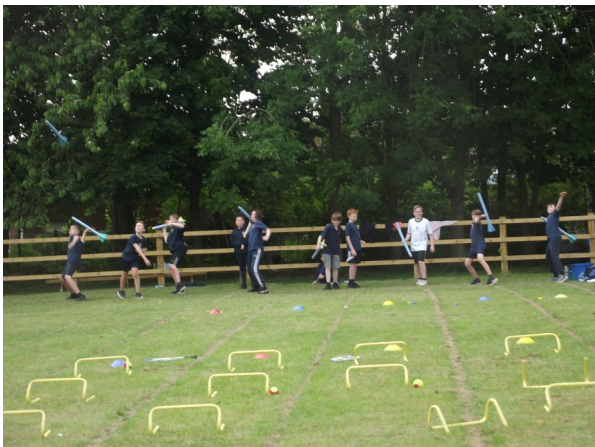
