**Admissions**

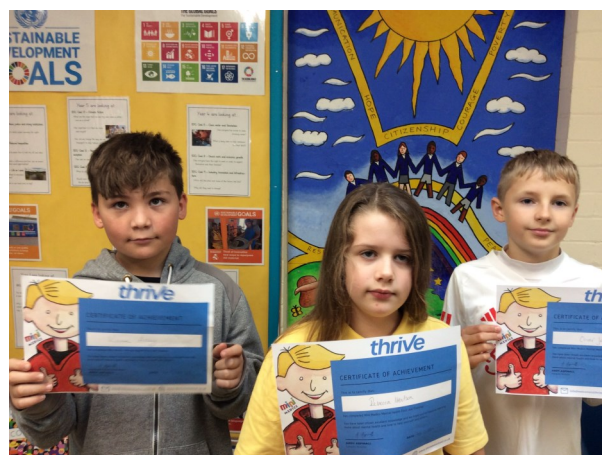
A quick reminder that the deadline for secondary admissions is the end of this month.
