In this week's worship, we discussed how we remember people. We thought about how sometimes our memories can be happy memories but others can be sad. Why not share items at home that help you to remember people or places?

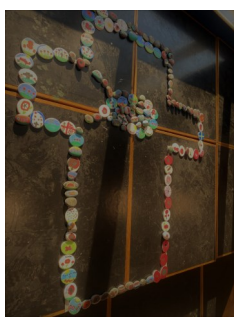
Remembrance
