Before allowing children to play a new online game, either try it yourself first, or research online to see if it's appropriate - paying attention to issues such as whether there's a chat system and whether the game they are playing is age appropriate.

The National Online Safety group have created a free guide for parents & carers for your school to share about 'Playerunknown's Battle-grounds' (PUBG) - a game played by millions of children and young people worldwide.

The guide is designed to inform parents and carers about the dangers and risks of letting their children play PUBG and how they can help keep their children safe online.
