# Finances

We currently have £15,892.73 owed to school. This includes £4343 in breakfast club fees, £8031 in after school club charges, £1429 for school lunches, £765 in snack payments and £1324 for holiday club provision. This shortfall has an impact on our school budget and therefore, provision for the children. Please could I ask all parents to check your parent pay accounts and make any necessary payments as soon as possible. ### Worship—Love God and Love One Another

The Parable of the Unforgiving Servant, Matthew 18, was shared in worship this week.

After Peter asks Jesus how often he should forgive someone who sins against him, Jesus tells the story of a servant whose enormous debt is forgiven by the king, but the servant then refuses to forgive a smaller debt owed to him. We discussed that God will forgive all sins, and it got us thinking about how we can forgive others when we make mistakes.

We also continued our lent learning and Rev. Sandi told us about the temptation of Jesus. We thought about what we may be tempted by.



We have re-established our link with St Lwanga Catholic School in Njoro, Kenya. We sent letters about life in Brereton, a school jumper and a parachute signed by all the children out with Alison Hooper who was the global schools link. Grace Irungu, headteacher, and Mrs Wood have had several email communications and our first main project will look at how we prepare for and celebrate Easter. Alison Hopper has delivered two staff meetings with our staff sharing her knowledge of Kenya and St Lwanga and working with subject leaders on global learning.

### Cheshire East Family Hub



## Easter Egg Raffle


