keep it looking nice.

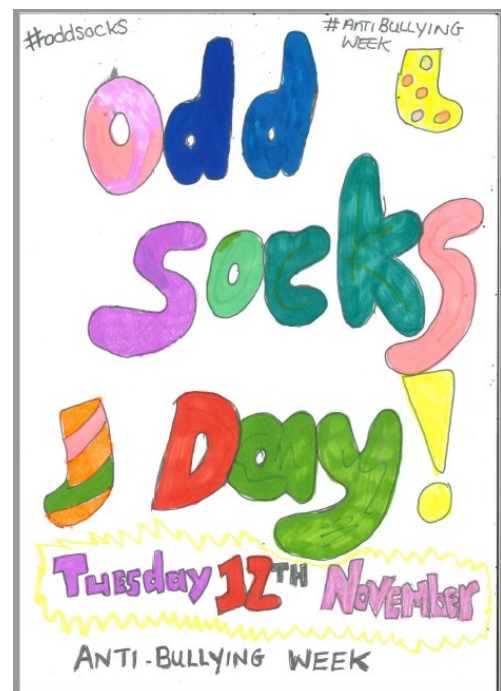
Please can we remind parents that The Bear's Head car park is available for before and after school drop off.
