Happy New Year to all our families. We hope you all had a wonderful Christmas and let's hope 2022 is filled with joy, peace and laughter.

Coronavirus

The self-Isolation period has now been reduced if parents/guardians confirm to school that:

- Children are well and symptom free
- They have had 2 negative LFT, at least 24hours apart
- They do not return before 8th day after their symptoms started or they took a positive test, e.g., if symptoms started on Monday 1st then the earliest date of return would be Tuesday 9th

This also applies to children under 5.

If there is a positive case of coronavirus in the household, we ask that pupils remain at home for 5 days and return to school once they have had a negative PCR result.

Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test.

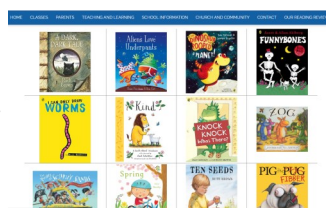
Please notify the school office if your child is absent from school by phoning and leaving a message. If your child tests positive for coronavirus, please email covid@breretonprimary.org.uk
