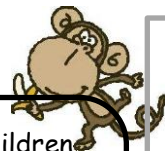


# Literacy



Using Pie Corbett's Talk 4 Writing, the children will continue to learn story maps off by heart and then innovate them to create their own writing. We will be focusing on making our stories exciting and writing Non-Chronological Reports.

The children will compare and contrast the habitat and weather changes between London and Kenya. We will look at the geographical environment and discuss similarities and differences. The children will look at maps of the underground.

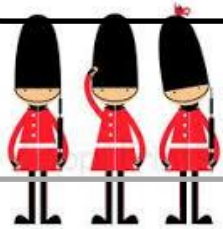
