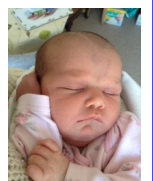

All school meals must be paid for in advance. Should you wish to pay for meals in full for this half term, the total would be 36 meals @ £2.20 = £79.20. Please pay for meals by cash or cheque to the school office or online using the Cheshire East payment system.

School Visits

We would like to offer an online payment system for making payments for school visits. This can be done via the Cheshire East ePayment system, the same system as payments for school meals. Each visit organised will be set up on the ePayments system for you to access to make a payment and consent to your child taking part. If you prefer you can still make a payment by sending it into school in an envelope clearly marked.
