

# Communication and Language

The children will listen to and learn to retell well known fairy tales, such as Rapunzel, Rumpelstiltskin and The Elves and the Shoemaker. We will be taking part in lots of drama and role play activities.

# Literacy

The children will listen to a range of fairy tales and create character descriptions. We will challenge them to sequence events and as our phonics skills develop we will write lists, labels, captions and invitations.

In Phonics we will be learning Speed Sounds 1 and Pink Band High Frequency Words.

# Expressive Arts and Design

The children will learn how to mix colours and how to combine materials to create collages. We will create portraits, shields and crowns.

We will also be looking at medieval music and creating a dance for a ball.

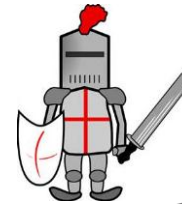

## Understanding of the World
