St Oswald's Family Remembrance Service on Sunday 8 November at the earlier than usual time of 10am. This will be a Parade Service for Brereton Scout Group and will be followed by an Act of Remembrance at Brereton War Memorial. There will of course be refreshments after the service.

We have received notification of an incident of threadworm. We would ask parents to talk to their child about the need to wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after using the toilet and dry them properly.

Threadworm is quite common in children but we do need to highlight this problem to ensure early detection and early treatment is sought. Should you have any queries please contact your local GP or Pharmacy for advice.

We have also had reports of head lice in school. I would therefore ask if parents could please check their child's hair, whether long or short each day.

Please be respectful to our neighbours when parking to pick up your child/children from school. The Bear's Head has generously said that you can all park on their car park. If there are no safe parking spaces please use this facility to park safely and walk round to the school

Please DO NOT cross the car park at the beginning and the end of the school day. Follow the feet on the path. It is for the safety of you and your children.
