Parking

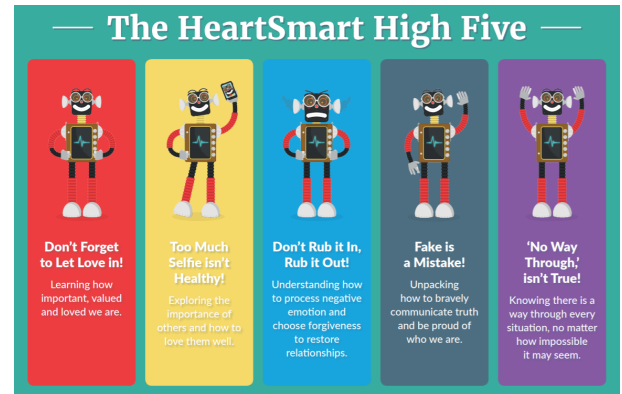


Please be mindful of where you park and do not block junctions or access. Please try and use the pub car park if you can.

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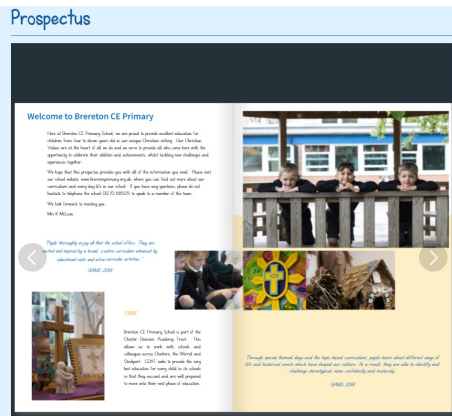
Reception 2021
