Coronavirus

If your child or a member of your household tests positive for coronavirus please notify school immediately by e-mailing covid@breretonprimary.org.uk

Contacting us early will ensure we have sufficient time to contact Public Health and plan accordingly.

If your child is at home because a member of the household has tested positive and they themselves then show symptoms, please access a test and notify school of the results immediately.

We are continuing to see positive cases amongst parents so please ensure that you keep two metres apart from one another and from staff.

Yesterday it was confirmed Cheshire will be in Tier 2 when the national lockdown ends.

TIER 2 HIGH ALERT FROM 2 DEC

MEETING FRIENDS AND FAMILY No mixing of households indoors, apart from support bubbles. Maximum of six outdoors.	BARS, PUBS AND RESTAURANTS Pubs and bars must close, unless operating as restaurants. Hospitality venues can only serve alcohol with substantial meals. Venues must stop taking orders at 10pm and must close by 11pm.	RETAIL Open.	WORK AND BUSINESS Everyone who can work from home should do so.
EDUCATION Early years settings, schools, colleges and universities open. Childcare, other supervised activities for children, and childcare bubbles permitted.	INDOOR LEISURE Open.	ACCOMMODATION Open.	PERSONAL CARE Open.
OVERNIGHT STAYS Permitted with household or support bubble.	WEDDINGS AND FUNERALS 15 guests for weddings, civil partnerships, wedding receptions and wakes; 30 for funerals.	ENTERTAINMENT Open.	PLACES OF WORSHIP Open, but cannot interact with anyone outside household or support bubble.
TRAVELLING Reduce the number of journeys you make and walk or cycle if possible. Avoid busy times and routes on public transport. Avoid car sharing with those outside of your household or support bubble. Avoid travelling outside your area, or entering a Tier 3 area, other than where necessary such as for work or education. Further exemptions apply.	EXERCISE Classes and organized adult sport can take place outdoors, but cannot take place indoors if there is any interaction between people from different households. Organized activities for elite athletes, under-18s and disabled people can continue.	RESIDENTIAL CARE COVID-secure arrangements such as substantial screens, visiting pods, and window visits. Outdoor/airtight visits only (in lieu of rapid testing will enable indoor visits including contact).	LARGE EVENTS Sport, live performances and business meetings limited to 50% capacity or 2000 people outdoors (whichever is lower) and 50% capacity or 1000 people indoors (whichever is lower).

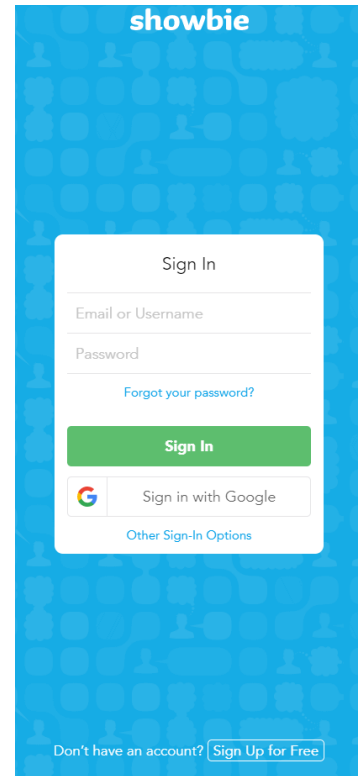

All pupils have an account for Showbie, so when signing in, you do not need to set up an account. Simply click 'Sign in' and you will see this page. The pupil then enters their log in details. For ease, we have set these up to be the same as their School Spider log ins and these should all be stuck in pupil planners.

If you are having difficulty with Showbie please e-mail the school office. In the event of a bubble closing there will be very little notice so we want to ensure everyone is ready to go should that happen.

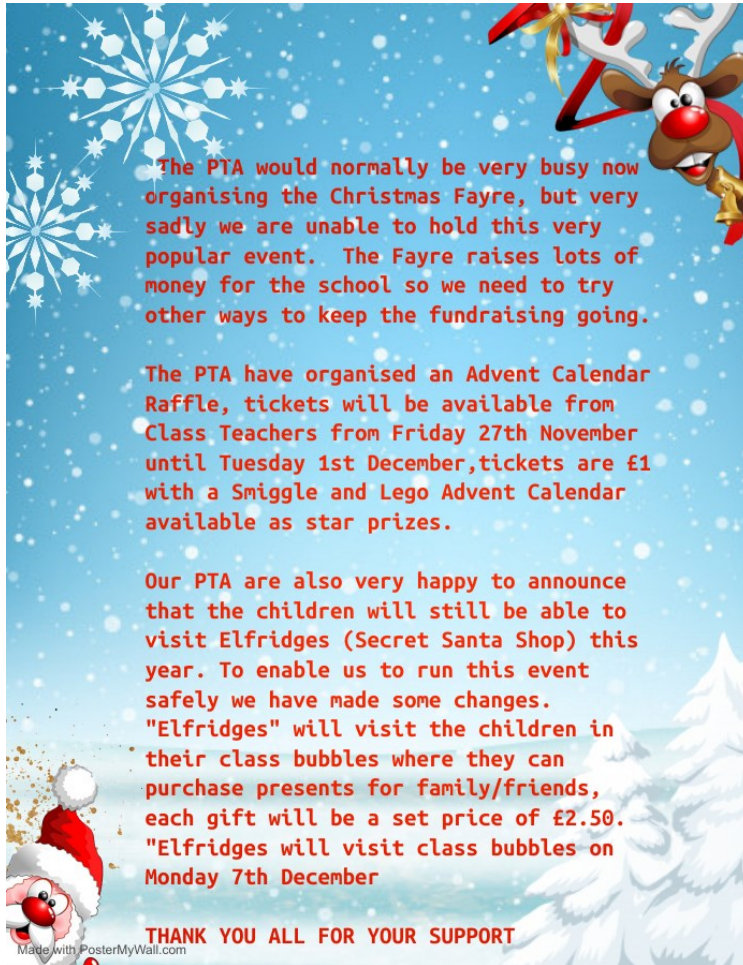
