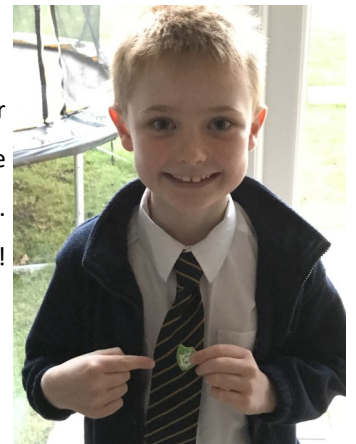
Pupils are invited to come to school in non-uniform on their Christmas lunch day so Christmas jumpers at the ready!

## TIER 2 HIGH ALERT

**FROM 2 DEC**

<b>MEETING FRIENDS AND FAMILY</b> No mixing of households indoors, apart from support bubbles. Maximum of six outdoors.	<b>BARS, PUBS AND RESTAURANTS</b> Pubs and bars must close, unless operating as restaurants. Hospitality venues can only serve alcohol with substantial meals. Venues must stop taking orders at 10pm and must close by 11pm.	<b>RETAIL</b> Open.	<b>WORK AND BUSINESS</b> Everyone who can work from home should do so.
<b>EDUCATION</b> Early years settings, schools, colleges and universities open. Childcare, other supervised activities for children, and childcare bubbles permitted.	<b>INDOOR LEISURE</b> Open.	<b>ACCOMMODATION</b> Open.	<b>PERSONAL CARE</b> Open.
<b>OVERNIGHT STAYS</b> Permitted with household or support bubble.	<b>WEDDINGS AND FUNERALS</b> 15 guests for weddings, civil partnerships, wedding receptions and wakes; 30 for funerals.	<b>ENTERTAINMENT</b> Open.	<b>PLACES OF WORSHIP</b> Open, but cannot interact with anyone outside household or support bubble.
<b>TRAVELLING</b> Reduce the number of journeys you make and walk or cycle if possible. Avoid busy times and routes on public transport. Avoid car sharing with those outside of your household or support bubble. Avoid travelling outside your area, or entering a Tier 3 area, other than where necessary such as for work or education. Further exemptions apply.	<b>EXERCISE</b> Classes and organised adult sport can take place outdoors, but cannot take place indoors if there is any interaction between people from different households. Organised activities for elite athletes, under-18s and disabled people can continue.	<b>RESIDENTIAL CARE</b> COVID-secure arrangements such as substantial screens, visiting pods, and window visits. Outdoor/airtight visits only (rollout of rapid testing will enable indoor visits including contact).	<b>LARGE EVENTS</b> Sport, live performances and business meetings limited to 50% capacity or 2000 people outdoors (whichever is lower) and 50% capacity or 1000 people indoors (whichever is lower).
