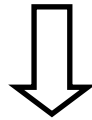

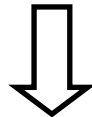


Coronavirus

You must inform school if child is symptomatic and seeking a test
up until 3:30pm 22nd December by e-mailing covid@breretonprimary.org.uk



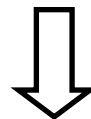
Parents to inform school of the results (positive or negative) by emailing covid@breretonprimary.org.uk
PLEASE DO NOT EMAIL THE OFFICE OR CLASS TEACHERS

Test is positive



Senior leaders will identify close contacts and e-mail parents are carers to inform them that they need to self isolate.

Test is negative



Senior leaders will record the result and Monitor the situation.

If any bubbles close next week due to a positive case, it is highly likely families will have to isolate over Christmas. Please be extra cautious and if your child is unwell, please do not bring them to school.
